III. **Review and Approve** (Lynn J 2nd Lori U) 7/25/18 PC Minutes Approved

IV. **Financial Council Report:** No report from the committee. Lynn Miller brought the question whether she was the liaison to the Finance Committee as she had already agreed to take the liaison assignment to the Joint Catholic Life Center. (See below)

V. **Motion:** To accept Patty Langel to the Council (replace Dale). To accept Bill Rutten to the Council (replace Molly). To nominate Susie Barrock to sit on council to complete the opening starting Sept 2018 and ending in 2021. (Matt M 2nd Lori U) Approved

VI. **Committee Liaison Reports:** Lynn M reported that last year there were more than 381 STE participants and 1371 BT participants using the Joint Catholic Life Center. (187 miscellaneous participants also.) A questionnaire has been put together to explore what various activities should be considered for 2018/19.

Patty reported for the RE Committee: 2 RE members attended an exciting and full of information seminar at the Archdiocese in August. Enrollment for RE is classes is very low (22 students). It was decided to send out reminders via internet, calls, bulletin, etc. Priority.

Susan reported on the Spiritual Life and Worship Committee: Zach confirmed we would be ready with new song books (cost approx. \$16.00 per book and Qty: 400). Stand would also be available by Nov/Dec.

Lori reported that St Anne's Society would sponsor a table for the Anchor of Hope charity.

Lynn J shared that the Salvation Army Lunch was a huge success. Many attendees and many volunteers. Delicious food as well.

Steve Kovacs requested a time to speak with the council to discuss Faith in our Future.
