

## Annual Stewardship Financial Commitment Weekend October 20/21

Our annual stewardship financial commitment form mailing occurred a couple weeks ago, and you are a key stakeholder at Blessed Trinity Parish! Your financial commitment form helps set the budget for the next fiscal year which begins in January 2019. Your participation is an act of good stewardship as pledges help your parish set goals, make plans, and manage any adjustments accordingly. As a stakeholder, you should expect your parish to operate efficiently and effectively, both in terms of finances and volunteer ministry resources. Stewardship involves time, talent, treasure, prayer, service and sharing. Blessed Trinity's Financial Stewardship takes place in the Fall and the Time/Talent Stewardship takes place in the spring.

October 20/21 is our annual Stewardship Financial Commitment Weekend. To return your form, you can either bring it to the weekend Masses on October 20/21, mail it to the Parish Office, or drop it off at the Parish Office during normal business hours.

Since you are a key stakeholder in Blessed Trinity, you can contribute to parish stewardship simply by returning your form by October 21st. A follow up mailing will be sent in November to remind any parishioners who are unable to return the forms by October 21st. Few would consider this to be a glamorous process and this annual task requires significant effort. We ask that you please prayerfully consider your financial commitment and help make the process as smooth as possible by returning your form in a timely manner. 
