

HOLY WEEK & EASTER INFORMATION

HOLY THURSDAY: Institution of the Holy Eucharist & Holy Orders-Solemn Mass at St. John's at 7:00 pm. At the conclusion, the altar is stripped. The church will be open for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for one hour after Mass.

GOOD FRIDAY: Recalls the suffering and death of Our Lord on the Cross. The 1:30 pm liturgical service at Blessed Trinity includes the reading of the Passion, Veneration of the Cross and Holy Communion. The collection is for the Holy Land shrines.

HOLY SATURDAY/EASTER VIGIL: Night watch of the Lord's Resurrection is at 7:30 pm at Blessed Trinity. This beautiful and inspiring Mass includes the Service of Light, Liturgy of the Word, Blessing of Water and Renewal of Baptismal Promises. *Holy Saturday Mass fulfills the Easter Sunday obligation.*

CONFESSIONS: There will be **no** 3:00 pm Confessions at St. John's on Saturday, April 20.

HOLY WATER: Bottles of Holy Water, which were blessed at the Easter Vigil, will be available at the church entrances beginning Easter Sunday. You are invited to take one of these bottles home with you. Holy water is a sacramental which reminds us of our relationship with God and enables us to act in accordance with God's will. One bottle per family, please.
