Mission Needs

We welcome **Father Jackson Colon** to Blessed Trinity & St. John Evangelist Parishes on the **weekend of May 11/12**, as part of our Annual Mission Appeal Weekend. He is from Haiti. Father Jackson will be speaking on behalf of the **Sisters of Saint Theresa of the Infant Jesus of Haiti** at all the Masses for the annual Missionary Cooperation Appeal, sharing his faith and the mission of the Sisters in Haiti and in Latin America, and soliciting financial support from the congregation. Some of their mission stations were destroyed by a powerful earthquake a few years ago and other natural disasters. Life, for most of the people in Haiti, has yet to return to normal, simply because they do not have the resources for even the most basic of daily needs. Father Colon's country is experiencing the worse troubling times now after several natural disasters and tragedies that struck Haiti in recent years.

We pray that you will reach out with your usual generosity to the Sisters and the people of Haiti in a spirit of support, love and prayer. **Missionary Cooperation Plan envelopes will be attached to the May 5 bulletin. The weekend of May 11/12, a second collection will be taken after Holy Communion. Please make checks payable to Blessed Trinity Parish.
