Friday, June 14 at 6:30 PM: Benediction & Novena Prayer followed by an Ice Cream Social

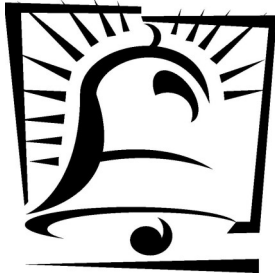
Saturday, June 15 at 4:00 PM: Holy Mass

Joe would be happy to speak with you. If you would like to contribute specifically for this project, please mark your check accordingly in the memo line. We thank you for your continued support.

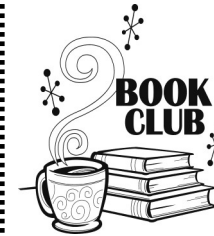
