Every one of us cannot be a missionary, but we can definitely cooperate with those engaged in the missionary work, so let us welcome Fr.

Father Jackson will be sharing his faith and the mission of the Sisters in Haiti and in Latin America, and soliciting financial support from the congregation. Some of their mission stations were destroyed by a powerful earthquake a few years ago and other natural disasters. Life, for most of the people in Haiti, has yet to return to normal, simply because they do not have the resources for even the most basic of daily needs. Father Colon's country is experiencing the worse troubling times now after several natural disasters and tragedies that struck Haiti in recent years.

We pray that you will reach out with your usual generosity to the Sisters and the people of Haiti in a spirit of support, love and prayer. **Missionary Cooperation Plan envelopes are attached to the bulletin. ## NOTICE FOR TRUSTEE NOMINATION

The position of Parish Trustee-Treasurer at Blessed Trinity Parish is open for nominations. The Trustee-Treasurer is responsible for keeping accurate and detailed accounts of receipts and disbursements for the parish. Blessed Trinity Parish has paid staff who carry out these accounting functions. The Trustee-Treasurer's particular responsibility is that of parish treasury activities. This includes the care and custody of funds, assets, supervision of banking, credit and insurance. The Trustee-Treasurer is an ex-officio member of the parish Pastoral Council and serves on the parish Finance Council. For more information, please read the Trustee-Treasurer Position Description on the back of the **Trustee Candidate Nomination Form**.

Nominees must be practicing Catholics who are parish members and are at least 25 years old.

Nomination forms are available in the pews, in the Parish Office and on the parish website at [www.btsje.org](http://www.btsje.org) (hover over the Blessed Trinity drop-down menu and select Councils). Each Trustee Candidate Nomination Form must be signed by 10 parish members who support the nomination (Pastoral Council members can assist with this). Nominees will be required to authorize a credit report for the pastor to review.

Trustee Candidate Nomination Forms can be placed in the boxes labeled "Trustee Nominations" (located at all church entrances) or dropped off at the Parish Office until **Friday, May 24, 2019**. The Trustee Election will be held during the weekend Masses of June 8/9, 2019.
